ARTICLE V

ELIGIBILITY

SECTION I - AGE

- A. In order to be eligible for interscholastic competition in athletics, contestants must be under 19 years of age prior to July 1

SECTION II - COMPETITION

- A. Any post-graduate or home-schooled student is ineligible for competition of any contest.
- B. Only full-time students on track to receive a diploma from a member school are eligible for competition

SECTION III - VARSITY LEVEL

- A. To compete on the secondary school varsity level, a student must be in eighth grade or higher to compete in Soccer, Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Volleyball, and Lacrosse.
- B. Students in grades 7 may compete in Track, Tennis, Cross Country, Bowling, and Golf.
- C. Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 may compete in Robotics, Chess, and Debate.

SECTION IV – APPEALS FOR ELIGIBILITY

- A. All disputes/appeals for eligibility will go to the appeals committee, which consists of the President, Vice-President, and Commissioner of that particular sport.
- B. The commissioner will submit a written report of the actions taken to the Secretary and President by the next Association meeting. Protests must be made within 5 days of the event. All decisions made by the appeals committee will be shared within 7 days of the appeal. All decisions are final and not eligible for further appeal.
