The Katherine Albe Shaftel '98 Memorial Scholarship

The Villa Class of 1998 is establishing a scholarship in loving memory of their classmate and friend Katherine Albe Shaftel. This scholarship will be given to a young woman who gives back to her community through contributions in volunteering, fine arts, leadership, mentorship or being a good friend and ally to those in need. One award will be given per year.

Kate was an actress and singer at VVA and then graduated from Westminster Choir College, where she earned a BA in Music and sang under the batons of some of the greatest conductors of our time. In her career, she was an awardwinning fine-arts fundraiser who was essential to the ongoing transformation of the Ohio University College of Fine Arts. Prior to that she helped alumni and friends to make positive change as a fundraiser at Westminster Choir College and the American Boychoir School in Princeton, New Jersey. During her lifetime she raised over \$15 million to support the arts.

Kate's life was short but left the world a better place. Her actions and presence filled the world with more light, love, and empathy. She is pictured below with her daughter Elena.


