Tricia Bitetto '04 manages Venture Café Cambridge, New England's largest weekly tech networking event. Under her leadership, attendance has grown by 40%, with 450 weekly participants and 20,000+ annually. She curates 300+ speakers across sectors and recently featured fellow alumna Alicia Froio '08.

Tricia is also involved with other exciting projects!

She serves on the South by Southwest (SXSW) Pitch 2026 Advisory Board. For this she is working on the startup pitch portion of the SXSW conference/festival. She will be reading 75-100 pitch decks to help vet applications for the 25 in-person spots for the event in March 2026.

She is also part of the TEDxHarvard Square 2026 Curation Team, which is choosing speakers for the annual local TED event happening in February 2026.

VVA Alum named to University Honors Program

Kutztown University has announced that 351 students will be part of the university's Honors Program in 2025-2026, including Emilie Asch '25 of Browns Mills, New Jersey.

The Honors Program at Kutztown University provides high-achieving students with opportunities to engage in scholarship, leadership and service. The program, which is undergraduate in nature and open to full-time students, is comprised of a minimum of 21 credits in Honors courses including a senior Honors capstone project. The 21 Honors credits count toward the students' minimum of 120 credits that are regularly required for graduation. Honors students select specially designed Honors courses, course-by-contracts, independent studies and internships to earn Honors credit. Students are also required to complete 30 hours of community service before graduation.


